

Necessary health controls for passengers arriving in Spain by air or sea

BOE-A-2020-14049- 11 November 2020

- All passengers arriving in Spain **by air or sea** must undergo a **health check before entering the country**. These controls may include a **temperature check, documentary control and a visual assessment** of the passenger's condition.
- All passengers arriving from any airport or port located outside of Spain must fill in a public health form [**Formulario de Control Sanitario/FCS**], through the Government website **www.spth.gob.es**, or the Spain Travel Health-SpTH app, before starting their trip.
- All passengers coming from a risk country or zone as listed in annex II who wish to enter Spain, must be able to show that they have a **Diagnostic Test for Active Infection (hereinafter, PDIA)** for SARS-CoV-2 with a **negative result**, which was taken within **72 hours prior to their arrival in Spain**.
