

# Capacity restrictions and specific prevention measures according to sector

In all cases, the necessary measures must be established to **ensure a safety distance is kept between people** at your premises or, where applicable, use alternative measures of physical protection.

**Wearing a mask will be mandatory**, even if the interpersonal distance of 1.5 metres is respected.

Space	Capacity	Specifications
Auditoriums, conference halls and similar spaces and facilities that are used to hold meetings and other such gatherings	<b>50% of their authorised capacity</b> in each room or space, with a <b>maximum of 400 people</b> .	It must finish no later than 9:00 pm.
Outdoor cultural activities and events	<b>50% of their authorised capacity</b> , up to a <b>maximum of 600 people</b> .	The audience must remain <b>seated and will require a pre-allocated seat</b> .  It must finish no later than 9:00 pm.

Space	Capacity	Specifications
Establishments and services related to the hotel & catering industry, restaurants, <i>txokos</i> and gastronomic societies.	<p><b>Completely closed to serving the public.</b></p> <p>Meals may only be served for delivery or collection by appointment up until 9:00 pm.</p>	The exception to this rule is for dining rooms at hotels and other accommodation premises to serve guests staying in said establishments.
Communal areas in hotels, camp sites and tourist accommodation	<p><b>50%</b>, and under no circumstances may the limit of 30 people at any given time be exceeded.</p>	<p><b>Cocktails and buffets may be held in maximum groups of 6 people</b> per indoor premises or outdoor area that is adequately defined.</p>
Trade fair sites	<p><b>Maximum capacity of 50%</b> in each room or space.</p>	<p>All the mechanisms must be in place to ensure a safe environment. There must be a <b>strict protocol</b> to be followed on all aspects: access control, traffic monitoring...</p>

Night clubs and other nightlife establishments.	<b>All night clubs, discos, dance halls etc. must remain closed</b> , as well as any establishments that are classified under groups III and IV, according to the [Spanish] Decree 17/2019 of 5 February, which approves the regulation implementing the Law on public events and leisure activities.
