(\* ) If in the Level 5 Scenario, Very High Transmission, rates reached 700/100,00 and rising, we would consider extraordinary measures as follows: (1) reassessing the request to amend the Royal Decree on the State of Emergency and bring forward the start of the night-time curfew as much as necessary or, in extreme cases, various possible lockdown measures; (2) bringing forward the end of activities and closure of establishments; (3) further restrictions on capacities; (4) suspension of activities; (5) suspension of events; (6) suspension of sporting activities; (7) assess proposals to maintain maximum in-person attendance in education; and (8) assess restrictive measures or perimeter lockdowns applied to a district, town/city, region or Historical Territory, depending on the severity of the situation.
